Dear Ms. Bose:


On February 20, 2015, numerous church members received letters from Mr. Phil Novak, Project Manager, Coates Field Services, Inc., 550 N. Eisenhower Drive, Suite C, Beckley, West Virginia, 25801, stating that EQT Corporation and NextEra US Gas Assets, LLC, had announced the proposal for the Mountain Valley Pipeline. Also, the letter indicated that these members have "been identified as having property that is located within the proposed survey corridor".


In early March, several of our members received phone calls from Mr. Nick Costantini, Field Agent, Coates Field Services, Inc., seeking their permission to send a survey team to survey their property. Dr. J. Wayne King, a member and Elder of our church, was contacted by Mr. Constantini regarding a time to survey his property. Dr. King indicated that before any surveying was done on his property, he wanted to see the actual path the pipeline would take through his land. Mr. Constantini sent the enclosed map for Dr. King to review, which indicated the centerline would go through our Church. However, Mr. Costantini phoned Dr. King two days later stating the wrong map had been sent. When asked to send the correct map, Mr. Constantini said Dr. King could follow the survey team as they surveyed the route on his land.


Regardless of which route Mountain Valley Pipeline uses, it appears the alternate route they have proposed will come through our section of Craig County, running dangerously close to the location of the Forks of Johns Creek Christian Church, which has been in its current location for 160 years.


Therefore, we the Elders and the Minister, representing the entire membership of the Forks of Johns Creek Church, **strongly urge you as the Secretary of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission to deny approval of any gas pipeline coming through Craig County.** It would be a grave mistake to scar our beautiful, pristine environment with something as ugly and dangerous as a gas pipeline.
