Report to the Craig County Board of Supervisors October 1, 2015

Summary of MVP, ACP and Craig County Events and Activities since 9/3/2015 Board Meeting

1. Preserve Craig will hold Public Meeting and Candidate Forum next Tuesday, October 6.
2. MVP surveys in Craig County have slowed.
3. MVP is buying Rights of Way in Monroe and Summers County, WV including right to add a second pipeline at the same price.
4. Preserve Craig has funded Cultural Attachment document for submission to FS & FERC.
5. Preserve Craig has funded legal arguments for a Programmatic EIS.
6. Multi-county study of Economic Impact of MVP draft being reviewed for publication.
7. Forest Service issued expanded MVP survey permit today for Alt 200.
8. MVP announced that Roanoke Gas Co. is taking a 1% ownership in MVP today.
9. Atlantic Coast Pipeline (ACP) filed formal application with FERC on 9/18/2015.
10. Federal Judge ruled that VA Pipeline Survey law does not violate US Constitution on 9/30/2015.
11. Continuing to work with Senators and Congressmen to investigate the FERC.
12. Continuing to post weekly updates at several locations around the County.
13. Seven months of work completed to date – over 1250 pages submitted on behalf of community to defend Craig County. Over 13,000 volunteer hours valued over \$300,000.
14. Watchdogging Williams possible Route for another Gas Pipeline through Craig County.
15. Participating in Regional Meetings with other Counties in Virginia and West Virginia.
16. MVP intends to file formal application later this month, in October “on schedule”.
