## **Report to the Craig County Board of Supervisors November 3, 2016**

### **Mountain Valley Pipeline (MVP), Atlantic Coast Pipeline (ACP) and Craig County Events and Activities since the September 2016 Board Meeting**

- 1. Comments to the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) are due by December 22, 2016. We are requesting that it be withdrawn as inadequate and incomplete.**
- 2. FERC “public” meetings to receive comments via private session with a stenographer are being held this evening from 5 to 10 PM at the Sheraton in Roanoke and in Peterstown, WV.**
- 3. An alternative truly public meeting is being held today at the Sheraton as well.**
- 4. The Preserve Craig Calendar for 2017 is now available Calendar. Donations appreciated!**
- 5. Preserve Craig is circulating a national petition to ask the Forest Service and other public representatives to demand the DEIS be withdrawn and permits not be issued.**
- 6. A survey of other counties shows MVP has not updated its public filings since October, 2015.**
- 7. Jake Lemon of Trout Unlimited is planning water monitoring training for all interested preserve groups in Blacksburg on Saturday, December 10, 2016. Time tba.**
- 8. Preserve Craig submitted as intervenor the Army Corps of Engineers national permitting comments (DPMC-12 comments) for inclusion on the docket.**
- 9. Fundraising to address the DEIS is now urgent.**
- 10. 20 months’ work to date – over 1900 pages submitted on behalf of community to defend Craig County representing over \$255,000 in volunteer efforts.**
